

## Port of St. George's - Port Specifications

The **Port of St. George's** is located in position **12°03'N, 61°45'W** on the south-west side of the mainland, and is operated by the Grenada Ports Authority from its offices at Burns Point, St. George's on the Carenage.

The **Melville Street Cruise Terminal** is a dedicated cruise facility situated on the foreshore of the west side of downtown St. George's. This facility offers a 375m long jetty with 350m of usable berth, including 100m of dolphin and catwalk. The terminal operates scanners and X-ray equipment for both disembarking and embarking passengers using this facility. Passengers exit directly through the newly opened Esplanade Shopping Mall and out to downtown St. George's.

The **Inner Harbour** is a general service facility, which has an 335 m quay with a water depth of 9 m alongside. Cruise ships are accommodated at the northern end of the quay, which boasts an open-air Tourist Information and Cruise Welcome Centre. Passengers exit onto the Carenage waterfront.

## General Information

Airport	The Point Salines International Airport is 6.5 miles from the Port of George's. The airport is served by regular airlines from North America, UK and the Caribbean.
Bunkers	Fuel is delivered by truck.
Charts	Please refer to Admiralty Charts BA799 and BA797.
Currency	The Eastern Caribbean (EC) dollar is fixed to the US dollar at a rate of EC \$2.7169 to US \$1.
Electricity	Power in Grenada is supplied at 220V, 50Hz
Location	St. George's, the main port of Grenada, is located in position 12 03'N, 61 45'W on the south-west side of the mainland, and takes in the area of water enclosed within a line from Point Salines to Point Moliniere.
Medical	A modern 300-bed hospital in St. George's plus private hospitals and clinics.
Passenger Access	Excellent ground connections include water taxis, bus services to major attractions and a taxi dispatch system for independent traveller.
Passenger Tax	A tax of US \$4.50 is payable by each passenger arriving at Port of St. George's.
Pilotage	Pilotage is compulsory for vessels over 200 grt. Port requires 24 hr notice for entering and 3 hours notice for departure. Pilot boards north-east of Annas Shoal. Pilots are available 24 hours a day.
Radio	The Grenada Ports Authority can be reached via VHF channel 16 using the call sign is Grenada Port Control and the call letters are J3YA. The Pilots call sign is Grenada Pilot (J3YB).
Tides	Little variation (no more than 0.61 m) between low and high tides.
Utilities	Full electrical, water and phone
Waste	It is prohibited to bring organic waste into Grenada. Facilities are available onshore for dumping non-organic waste.
Water	Fresh water is available alongside the main pier
Weather	Sunny climate all year. Average temperature 24 C to 30C. Rainy season from June to December.
Working Hours	07.00 – 12.00, 13.00 – 18.00 and 19.00 – 23.00
